



WEBSITE PRIVACY POLICY

Nimble e-solutions (**“we” or “us”**), is committed to making strong efforts to protect the personal information and privacy of all persons lawfully using our website. This Privacy Policy (the “Policy”) explains how we collect and use the personal information that you provide online to our website (the “Site”), as well as offline when participating in any Program run by the Company.

You should read this Policy before you submit any personal information to us. By using our Site or registering your interest in us online, you consent to the collection and use of your personal information as outlined in this Policy. The term “personal information” is defined in Section 2 below. If you do not agree with the content of this Policy, you should refrain from using our Site.

1. WHO WE ARE

2. PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

In general, we may collect and store any personal information you enter on our website or provide to us in some other manner. Personal information is data that identifies you, or that can be combined with other information to identify or contact you, and includes (but is not limited to) your name, business or personal email address, job title, organization, organization’s physical address, direct telephone number, photograph, and biographical details. You are not obligated to provide us with any personal information, although you may need to provide some information to submit a question or engage in other activity on our Site. We strive to limit the type of personal information that we collect to information that helps us accomplish our goal of providing first-class services.

3. INFORMATION FROM OTHER SOURCES



We also may periodically obtain both personal and non-personal information about you from other sources. Examples of information we may receive include updated contact information and additional information. Please note that we may have previously collected personal information relating to you at the time you or your organization enrolled in a Program/Service run by us

4. INFORMATION COLLECTED AUTOMATICALLY

When you visit our website, we automatically collect and analyze certain information about your computer. This information includes but may not be limited to the IP address used to connect your computer to the Internet, information about your browser type and language, the date and time you are accessing our Site, the content of any undeleted cookies that your browser previously accepted from us, and the referring website address.

We may use (or may contract with service providers to use) various technologies to collect information about your activities on our Site.

5. COOKIES

When you visit our Site, we may assign your computer one or more “cookies.” A cookie is a small text file that contains information that can later be read by us to facilitate your access to our Site and personalize your online experience. For example, whenever you visit our Site, we may automatically collect information about your online activity on our Site, such as the web pages you visit, the links you click, and the searches you conduct. Most browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser settings to decline cookies by visiting the Help portion of your browser’s toolbar. If you choose to decline cookies, please note that you may not be able to use some of the interactive features offered on our Site.



6. OTHER TECHNOLOGIES

We may use standard Internet technology, such as Web beacons (also called clear GIFs or pixel tags), locally stored objects (often referred to as “flash cookies”) and other similar technologies, to deliver or communicate with cookies and track your use of our Site and content presented via the Site. We also may include web beacons in e-mail messages to determine whether messages have been opened and acted upon. The information we obtain in this manner enables us to customize the services we offer and measure the overall effectiveness of our online content, advertising campaigns, and the products and services we offer through the Site.

7. INFORMATION COLLECTED BY THIRD PARTIES

Third-party vendors, advertising entities, and business partners (such as Google, by way of Google Analytics) may use cookies and other technologies (such as Web beacons) to collect information about your online activities. The purposes for collecting this information includes: to measure usage of our Site; to analyze, modify, and personalize content on our Site; and to provide information about goods and services we hope will be of interest to you. We do not have access to or control over cookies or other features these third parties may use, and the information practices of these third parties are not covered by this Privacy Policy. Some of these third parties may be third-party network advertisers that offer you the option of not having this information collected.

8. HOW WE USE THE INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Nimble-e solutions will not sell, rent, lease or barter your personal information to any third party, or pool your personal information with any third party.

In general, we use the information we collect about you for the following purposes:



- To respond to inquiries that you submit to us via the online “contact us” feature and determine which services will help you achieve your business goals;
- To send you information about services and solutions that you have requested or authorized from us;
- For the purposes for which you provided the information;
- To customize the content you see;
- To engage in research and analysis in order to maintain, protect and improve our Programs, Site and services, as well as develop new services;
- To generate anonymous and/or aggregated reporting, meaning that data collected from you is not identifiable within such reports;
- To enforce the legal terms that govern your use of the Site;
- To enhance our Site, network and our products and services;

10. DISCLOSURES OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

We may share your personal information with other companies or individuals in the following instances:

- When we engage service providers and third-party agents to process personal information on our behalf. When we do so, we contractually require these service providers to implement adequate technological and organizational security and privacy measures



before they can receive any personal information from us and they are each contractually bound to ensure that your personal information will be appropriately protected and only be used for the purposes of performing the services for us.

- For legitimate business purposes connected with the provision of our e-solution services, and for benefit of our clients. Where information is shared with a third party for a legitimate business purpose, we will seek reasonable assurances from that third party that the personal information will be processed for legitimate reasons and appropriately protected.
- In good faith in response to subpoenas, court orders, or other legal process; to establish or exercise our legal rights; to defend against legal claims; or as otherwise required by law. In such cases we reserve the right to raise or waive any legal objection or right available to us.
- When we believe it is appropriate to investigate, prevent, or take action regarding illegal or suspected illegal activities or attempted or actual breaches of our security; to protect and defend the rights, property, or safety of our company and clients, or others; and in connection with our Terms of Service and other agreements.
- In connection with a corporate transaction, such as a divestiture, merger, consolidation, or asset sale, and then under reasonable assurances of maintaining confidentiality, or in the unlikely event of bankruptcy.
- We also may share aggregate or anonymous information with third parties, including investors, lenders and partners, but always subject to reasonable assurances that confidentiality will be maintained. Aggregate or anonymous information does not contain any personal information, and its use and disclosure is not subject to the terms of this Policy.

11. ACCESS AND CORRECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

You can request access to any personal information that we hold about you and ask us to correct any personal information, which may be inaccurate, except where the law requires otherwise. To
